The GreenLight Fund is a national 501(c)(3) organization that brings innovative approaches to make measurable social impact in our communities. What we do:

GreenLight Fund Bay Area conducts an annual process to identify critical gaps and programming needs pertaining to low-income children and families. We then choose and invest in an innovative, high-performing organization that has significant, proven outcomes; and then galvanize local and national support across sectors to achieve sustainability and scale.

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Who we're looking for:

Seeking an entrepreneurial, organized, and research-focused intern who works independently and has experience/interest in serving children and families in the Bay Area. This intern will touch the many different parts of GreenLight's work—including fundraising diligence and research for prospect data management, creating content for social media and newsletters, and supporting administrative needs.

We are looking for someone who is interested in the Bay Area, philanthropy, and social justice, who works well with a team and is eager to take a lead on research and new projects.

Compensation and time:

This position pays a \$1,500 stipend. Expected start date is September 27, 2018 through December – start/end date is flexible, including either short-term or possibility for extension beyond December. Likely workweek is 10-20 hours with flexibility and opportunities for professional development.
