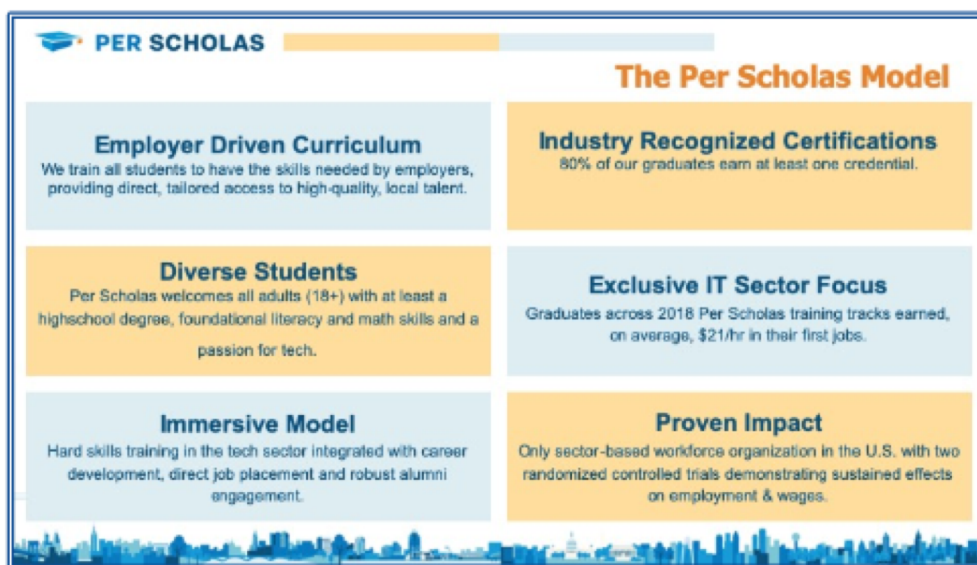

GreenLight Boston Welcomes Per Scholas

More than 60% of BPS graduates from the classes of 2000-2011 did not receive an Associates or Bachelor's degree within six years of graduation. Now older than 26 years old, these BPS graduates have few options – aged out of the young adult programs designed to move them into viable careers and out of poverty. Meanwhile, tech-related jobs in Massachusetts are expected to grow in the double-digits. Yet, more than 70% of employers in the tech sector report difficulty hiring, citing lack of training, technical skills, and industry-specific knowledge. The need is clear – Boston lacks an adult training program that prepares low-income adults for the jobs of now and the future, ultimately moving them and their families out of poverty.

GreenLight Fund Boston is proud to welcome Per Scholas – the 12th organization we've imported. Per Scholas provides tuition-free technology training and professional development for people from overlooked communities, and creates onramps to businesses in need of their talents.



Over the next four years, Per Scholas will train 800 curious, motivated individuals in the Greater Boston area, who are under and unemployed. Per Scholas helps adults launch successful careers in seven other cities; their data shows:

- 85% of students graduate
- 80% of students graduate with an industry-recognized certification
- 80% of graduates earn an average of \$21/hour to start
- Alumni earn 4 times their pre-training wage in their first job post-graduation, on average
