## About GreenLight Boston

GreenLight Fund Boston dismantles entrenched barriers and creates pathways to economic opportunities for children and families. We address local service gaps impacting low-wealth communities by importing innovative, results-oriented programs to our region. With a \$9.1 million investment in social impact models, we have a 16-year track record of success: launching twelve new organizations to Boston that reached over 300,000 children and families last year alone and leveraged \$75 million in funding.

GreenLight Boston has worked in partnership with communities of color to bring in innovative models to address pressing needs. Of the beneficiaries our portfolio of organizations serve, **78% identify as Black, Indigenous, or People of Color (BIPOC) with 45% identifying as Black.**

Further, 46% of our advisors, who support with the selection and portfolio management of our new portfolio organizations, identify as BIPOC.
